Aromatic Sauvignon Blanc with tropical fruit of gooseberry and passion fruit with a hint of lemon grass. Lees contact giving rise to a creamy mouthfeel with a crisp finish on the palate. A wine showing its true character from the Elim terroir. Best enjoyed now or until 2019.
